

Nancy Tuesday class #7 (3-24-92) (2 tapes)

Key Topics: Changing times, Indigos, Cuba, Philippines, Common Market, California

Nancy: What do you want to talk about today?

Other: The calls that have been coming in swing all the way from feelings of suicide to inadequacy about taking your life and letting it work for itself.

Nancy: What did I tell you that the Violet Age is? It is a transformation time to bring us more in alignment with ourselves. For the last 75,000 years, we have been learning how to live in the world. We have learned that very well. We have learned it so well that we don't realize we are not the world. So we have a lot of trouble separating ourselves from the world. And the Universe is saying right now, "Unless you know YOU, it is impossible to be self-sufficient." The Violet Age demands that we learn to be self-sufficient. We must learn to know the difference between the world and us. We have learned to depend on structure, not life. We think that if we get up at a certain hour and go to work and do certain things and then come home and do certain things and then go to bed and get a good night's sleep, then we will be healthy, wealthy, and wise, and we are discovering that that doesn't work. We are discovering that we have saved our money, we have invested it wisely, and it's gone. Because what the outer world says is going to work may or may not work in the future. And you don't know when it isn't going to work. That is the only way we can learn how to go back to the origin, the self, and learn to be sufficient to thyself. If you have nothing, you can always make more. And if you have everything, you can always lose it. The times are teaching us what we hold as idols in front of us. Remember the (?) Commandment: Thou shalt not have any graven images before you. That's what we are learning now. Which is more important to us? What's out here, or what's in here? Once we get that clear, what's in here (inside), we can manifest out here. But, you see, that's what I think is one of our great challenges is that the time is so chaotic, and what make it so scary is that we don't know what's in here (inside ourselves.) It's kind of like a garbage dump. We have taken so much garbage and dumped it in the landfill in here (our head) that we don't even know what's under the surface, and we are terrified to look because it might not serve us and it might explode in our face. We don't know ourselves and we don't trust ourselves to realize that we need to dig in here and clean out the landfill. We need to learn how to work with our inner selves. That's what it's all about. Until we get clear about what's in here, we are going to look at all that used to be wonderful and workable and marvelous out here becoming less and less workable. The more we get to know what's in here, the more out here works. (gesturing) The more we are clear about what's in here, the more this out here works for us. What we feel about that is a sense of detachment. And that's a plus because it means that this out here isn't the most important thing in your life and that you are not wrapped up in that. You may not be wrapped up in here either. And then you're kind of in limbo, no man's land. A lot of us are feeling that right now because we are having difficulty going in and looking at the garbage that's in there.

Other: This validates when you first started talking about the Violet Age publicly in 1981.

Nancy: This will last pretty much for the rest of this century. Individually you can do it, and it will go on until it is settled. Through destruction or through transformation. And transformation will have a bit of destruction attached to it, and it will have a bit of refurbishing too. One of the things God is doing is testing to see if man is ready for advancement. In other words, we are at a point in our evolution where if we take one road, we can go on into a more refined, more delicate, more peaceful, more loving human being that will drop a lot of 2nd dimension processes. You have all heard me talk about the 1st dimension, 2nd dimension, 3rd dimension, and the 4th dimension, and you have heard me say we are right

in “here” right now, getting our passport, so to speak, to cross the border. This dimension (1st) was passive, this (2nd) was aggressive, this one (3rd) is supposed to be passive / aggressive, which we call active, and this one (4th) is supposed to be peaceful, which is a combination of all the other three balanced. And so right now, we have to make a decision whether we want to move forward to a place where we can have what I call a utopia, what we’ve all dreamed about, that place of brotherhood and love and peace and harmony as human beings. In order to do that, this must be dropped. The aggressive (the animal) must be dropped because animals work instinctually. The basic structure of the animal is survival. The animal will kill in order to survive. So will man. But man likes to think that he is intelligent enough to negotiate and compromise and work things out. That’s what we are getting the test on now to see how well we can live and let live without laying down terms. Now you all know my constant preaching is learning how to accept people for who they are or are not. We have learned to accept them for who they are, but we have not yet learned to accept them for who they are not, which is who WE are. So we are still constantly trying to make people that we think we love in our image so we can be bored with them. And that we have to give up. Now that’s what the Violet Age is here to teach us – for us to learn to walk as individuals. Walking as individuals does not mean that we cannot walk together; in fact, it guarantees that we will. Because if I’m doing my number and not spending all my time watching yours, and if you’re doing your number and not spending all your time watching mine, then we are going to get along a lot better. But we all tend to look for what we don’t have. Then we have trouble letting other people be who they are not. We have trouble living with what we don’t have. And that’s what this age is to teach us. How do we do that? By focusing on what we want. Not what we don’t have and getting clear within ourselves that we want it not just because we don’t have it. We want it because we feel it will give us a better quality in living our life. That’s the point. Not to say I want this because I’ve never owned it. But to know why you want it, what good it is going to do in your life, and what your responsibility will be in owning it. Because every breath you take has a responsibility attached to it. And it has a benefit. You have to know that, not just want it because it’s not in your life, why you want it and for what purpose so the Universe can decide whether that serves ITS purpose or not. Because first and foremost, the Universe continues its process. It doesn’t ask you whether you like it or not, and it doesn’t really care. Because it knows anything it wants will benefit you if you are intelligent enough to see it. If it benefits the Universe, it benefits anything in the Universe. That’s our process. If we get in touch with ourselves, we have a direct modem to the Universe, and therefore, we will know what IT requires out of us in order to fit in the whole. That is what this age is all about. That is what this time is all about. And right now, our biggest problem is letting go of the past. The tan, the yellow, the green, the blue age. It’s not just the Blue Age we need to let go of. It’s all previous ages. Now you Violets should understand that because your lesson is to touch lightly, review, and move on. And Violets have trouble with that because all the Blues out there are telling them they should hold onto it. And all the Greens out there are telling them they should make something out of it, and all the Yellows are saying, “Be sensible,” and all the Tans are saying, “Get control of yourself.” And all the Violets are going (SHRUG).

Other: Where do I start?

Nancy: So what the Violets are going through on that level, the rest of us are too. Trying to see how we can survive in this world, and that’s not the answer. That’s what’s holding us back. The fact that we are all desperately seeking for a way to survive. What we need to do is to learn to look for a way to live, which means that I am content within here. Whatever comes that feels right to me, I will try it. I will be ready to step back if it isn’t working. Whatever doesn’t feel right, I won’t struggle to make it work. I’ll sleep on it. And once we learn to do that, we will be ... and while I’m doing that, I’ll concentrate on what is working for me, not what isn’t working for me. That is really important if we are to get our passport to move over into the 4th dimension. And the other great challenge with that is that, once we move over

into the 4th dimension, all the animalistic cells in our body that are required for survival must go. They must go because they are what create aggression for us. If that is what must go, then we have to realize that these bodies must change. They cannot go on in animal form over here (perhaps pointing to 3rd dimension.) Man has been going, throughout time, like this... (drawing on board.) And he suddenly reached a point where he started going this way and the animals kept going this way. So now we're over here going this way, and we have to get finer in our process and go more. The point is that we are at this point where we are making the transition, and this line is getting finer as it moves up. We are becoming more and more refined. For a while we looked like fish and then we looked like animals, and now the fish are still going one way and the animals are going another way and we are going another way. And we are trying desperately to keep them alive with us. You know I'm going to try to bring in environmental things with it. The path keeps getting broader. The more we try to hold it together, the more we slow ourselves down. So we have to learn how to go OUR way, to be satisfied with being man, not God, and not animal. But man, for that is who we are. We really need to learn to work on that. And we are at a point where we can go that way or we can go extinct. Our choice. Either way, we will go extinct.

Other: discussion of the recent news about a white whale from Russian research in Turkish waters.

Nancy: That is a responsibility that man takes when he starts taking care of animals. If he takes them out of their natural habitat, they lose their instinctual process. It's a lesson in evolution to see how quickly they can lose their instinctual process if things are provided for them. We have to make this decision within ourselves. We can do it ourselves, we can do it in a group, we can do it as a nation, we can do it as a world, but it can't be done by law. That has been proven because the Universe already has the law and it hasn't worked. The Universe already has the law, and we are not following it. And so, I oftentimes think about this. My head goes through funny avenues every now and then. Why do we wonder that we break social laws because we break universal laws so easily? And if we can break them so easily, then social laws are nothing. They have absolutely no bearing to the sense that we have broken universal laws. Our social law process right now is only a mirror to what we have done to the universe. In our process of not living honest, loyal lives to ourselves, we have allowed other people to make laws that are impossible to live with. And now we're trying to look at that because we have no way of coping with it. Transfer that same picture into the Universe. And the Universe says, "Ok, we gave you free will, we gave you choice. Your choice. Your choice was to not obey. And in that choice, we have allowed you to see where you will go. We have let you go to the limit of the law. Now the law will be in force. And you will do what you need to do." We are going to have to live with this, whether we like it or not. You are learning to recognize what you can do and what you cannot do. And more and more to learn to listen to yourself, to listen to what you feel is right is here for you. That may not be right for your neighbor; it may not be right for your husband. It may not be right for your wife. That doesn't mean you need to leave them. That means you learn to make choices and share. That's the key. Where we have this silly little idea that if they don't believe and live and do everything we do, then they can go out the door. Out you go. And we are not willing to say, "ok, you have your belief structure and I have my belief structure, and that's ok." Maybe if you share a few of your ideas, and I share a few of my ideas, we'll keep each other from walking off the cliff. We'll stay in the middle of the road. So those are some of the things that man has to learn before he can go into the peaceful territory. This territory (4th dimension) will not be contaminated by false realities. The 4th dimension says you will be totally peaceful, or you will not enter its portals. It doesn't say you will be totally at peace; it says you will be totally peaceful.

Other: In this transition period, I can see how all this is happening. But I can't see how it is going to happen to my body.

Nancy: Oh, yes, it IS going to happen to your body. It is already happening to your body. What do you think we call aging? (class laughter and comments). It takes generations. And there is nothing you can do about it except live your life the best you know how so that your part of evolution is done well. Somewhat like a relay race. You took the baton from your father, and you are evolving it one step further, and your son will take the baton from you and take it one step further and his son will take it one step further and will peacefully and gently change. But if we don't do that, what takes place? One goes extinct and the other one comes up. And what we have is a missing link. So that is the key. That if we continue to say, "We have no responsibility in physical evolution because we don't know it's taking place," there's a problem. That is the problem – is that we refuse to take responsibility for evolution. That's what happened when we had a Neanderthal here and for some reason they went extinct and the Cro Magnon flourished, and no one knows where they came from. The same thing can take place now. We see the Indigo children totally different. We see them responding to totally different foods, to different processes, different entertainment, different elements. We see that taking place. That is evolution in action. And we are the fortunate ones. We are the first generation to get to see that. People over 70 or 80 now do not get to see that because they don't even comprehend these little Indigos running around. They don't know what they are all about. I shouldn't say none of them do, but there are very few. More important than that, we must learn that we can assist the Indigos by changing with them – willingly.

Other: Is that through action?

Nancy: Yes, it is through action. We regard bioengineering as something that might be horrible, as something that might be terribly bad, something that is taking away the humanistic element. Is it? Of course it is. Let's look at an example. A pace-maker is a bioengineered product that does not beat faster just because it is under stress. A pacemaker will not overheat just because someone eats cholesterol. A steel joint in the hip will not fail because you aren't taking care of the bone structure. It might if the bones hook to it. There are some bioenergetics advancements that are being brought out that is teaching us the 4th Moral Lesson, which we refuse to learn with our natural body. We are pieces of machinery. That machinery has a given length of time, and like your car, if you take of it when it is new, it will last longer when it is old. If it gets regular maintenance, it will run much better than if you only wait for the knocks. Right? That's evolution. Bioengineering is teaching us a lot about the 4th Moral Lesson. {The 4th Moral Lesson is that a thing cannot live beyond its life span.} And it is true. We cannot restructure these bodies from the standpoint that we can't take a 1957 Chevrolet and make it into 1992 Chevrolet without totally taking away the '57 Chevy, pick up two entirely different chassis. Right? So on one level, you are absolutely right. We can't stop. We can't make this body do what the Indigos are doing. But we can learn to adjust to some of their things, which give them more permission to do theirs. And we can be willing to recognize that and to put the attitude into life for newness rather than holding onto the old attitude. In the 3rd dimension, we are either passive or aggressive. Indigos are active. And we need to learn from that. I see a lot us doing the same thing. I see a lot of us choosing to be active rather than passive or aggressive, but I see us afraid of it sometimes.

Other: Where they do not have that?

Nancy: Where they do not have that fear until it's instilled in them by their parents. We need to learn that change is inevitable. Change is always going on whether we acknowledge it or not. They key is that most of us, because of our consciousness, women want to stay 25 and men want to stay 16 within their internal self instead of recognizing that there is that part of us that will always be that way if we respect the other part. What do I mean when I make that statement? We should love the 25 and live the 50 and balance the two out without cursing the 50 because it can't do what the 25 did, but to do it in a different

way. That I see people doing more and more, and I think it is wonderful. But I think we need to be youthful, not young. There is a big difference. Being full of the attitude of youth but being who we are, to me, is the answer, and the same thing holds true here. These bodies will malfunction because they are old models going out of style. Fact. And we can be old and dissatisfied OR we can become a classic. That's our choice. And the system can be rewired by bioengineering. And that's what's happening on an over-all level. A lot of us are afraid of it, and a lot of us don't understand it, and a lot of us wish it weren't going on. A lot of people think it's against God's rule. Nothing is against God's rule. He created it all.

Other: sharing experience about pacemakers and their function. Further discussion about bioengineering and cloning.

Nancy: Indigos today are confused by their "given" and our "training." They are hardwired for a different kind of love than we are. We are trained to act and react to certain things that are not their program. Most of the oldest Indigos are 23 or 24 right now. They don't quite understand our mode and we don't quite understand theirs. That's the generation gap if you want to call it that. That's the time for refinement. It's what those people who have Indigos have to learn how to cope with. And that's what the Indigo, living with old-fashioned people, have to learn to cope with also.

Other: I see the Indigos are being able to look at something and just reproduce it.

Nancy: They don't see that as art. We do. When we do something we start instructions at Part A. They start instructions at Part C, as far as we are concerned. We don't know what they did at A and B because we didn't see them do it. It's a given. So we look at it and say, "wait a minute. You haven't done this and this and this." They look at it and say, "why? I don't need that."

Other: Sharing personal Indigo story about a young person running red lights.

Nancy: Remember in 1985 I talked about the Indigos not responding to red the way we did in our evolutionary cellular structure. They respond more to pink or green than we do.

Other: Is it rigid?

Nancy: Not rigid at all. Red doesn't mean stop to them, and green doesn't mean go. Red is like A and B to us. In another 5 years, if we wait that long, our red lights are going to change. Children cannot be herded by it. Another point... these children do not age as fast as we do, either physically or emotionally. Therefore at 20 they are doing what we did at 15. So their process of responsibility is not where we were at their age, and they are not as easily herded into the cattle bin. They want to do what??? They want to run free. They say, "these little bottled laws that put you in one big herd are defacing our process." And they are not following it. They are not following it. That's why, through the entire month of February, California had its amnesty law in operation, where people who had lots of tickets could go and have it removed for paying half or none of it. Because they just had too many outstanding tickets. These people just do not care. No big deal. Their spine doesn't ripple when a policeman goes by. And when they see a policeman make an illegal turn in the middle of the road because he forgot something or because he's chasing something, but still, that gives him no reason to make an illegal turn and then turn around and give somebody else a fine for doing the same thing. Nothing warrants that. But yet our government has gotten to the point of doing that. And that is what we see blowing up. That's all the talk about what Congressmen are doing with their perks and what policemen are doing with the people they are arresting. You are seeing the King trial on TV where they are trying the four policemen for brutality.

All of these things are being looked at that our authority as we knew it is proving to be inadequate and brutal. That's what the 2nd dimension is – brute force. That has got to go!

Other: Are we supposed to adjust to the ticket thing?

Nancy: What do you mean?

Other: That the Indigos think nothing of all these tickets?

Nancy: No, I think the government, or us, the people, have to find out why... see, to them (Indigos), to the computer, it is incomprehensible to make a car that can go 105 miles an hour and then tell you that you can only drive it 55. That is an illogical, unacceptable process. So Indigos say, "Why does it have 120 on the speedometer if we can only go 55?" Why do we do that? Human nature is to push to the limit. So why make cars that can go 125 when it is illegal to drive like that? I mean, that does not make good sense. Our commercial process sets us up to break the law and then we get punished for doing it. That is a dichotomy that we have to learn to work out. The same thing takes place with our politicians. They lie to us, then they get reelected, and then we get surprised they lie again. We have the same process in operation. So somewhere along the line we have to learn to build things that match our living conditions.

All the talk about the environment... what went up in the air this morning? The Space Shuttle, the one that's going to study Earth and Earth alone? We're going to find some surprising things out of this, make no mistake about it. We are going to discover that a lot of things we thought that were destroying the Earth's atmosphere in the past have nothing to do with it. We are going to discover that there's a lot other mysteries out there that we never heard of. Make no mistake about it. Now THAT's a happening for me. Because we are going to get clear about a lot of things, and a lot of our romance is going to have to die. But it may take 20 years because the dreamers are going to fight the realists. Some of them are going to say, "Well, it was just the machinery that discovered that. It isn't true."

Other: What kind of politicians are Indigos going to make?

Nancy: Probably none. I'm not saying they will not go into politics. What I am saying is that if there IS a government to go into at that time, they will give it back to the people. They will not stand there and do it. They will say, "What do you want?"

Other: Won't there be more small governments on a localized scale?

Nancy: We don't know. I think evolution demands that we become one unit. I think the day of man running the show is over. I think that we are going to have to know that man has to change and recognize his part in nature.

Other: group discussion about life in Europe and living in a Commonwealth.

Once the Common Market (in Europe) goes into effect, there will be chain reactions from that.

Other: What is that?

Nancy: All (most) of Europe, except Switzerland, is going into a common market and so they will all be operating under one commercial law and one money currency. They will still have their own script, but when they work with each other, there will be only one common currency. It will affect us, because instead of Europe getting 1.77 for a DM, Switzerland getting 1.56, England getting 1.7 pounds per dollar,

Italy having 50,000 lira to a hundred dollars (way out of balance), they will all have the same exchange value. The international process will work under that system. England will join it also. Once that takes place there will be a chain reaction. I have said in the past that Americans who have traveled to those countries in the past will not be able to travel as cheaply because when we go to those countries, no matter which one we are in, it will be the same. And they are starting at a high price; they are not starting at a low price. So that is bound to set off chain reactions for Asia, for the Middle East, for Spain, and it will affect us like a tidal wave. It will affect everything. We are in for some interesting changes. We shouldn't worry about it. Trying to figure it out before it gets here is what has gotten us into trouble so far. The key is just to learn to just look at it, note it, wait and see. It is my opinion that it is the preparation for the Common Market that has created our recession. We may not see that. We don't know what they are doing in the Common Market. We don't know how that will thread in this country. We are import / export; they are import/ export. It will affect us.

Other: What colors are all the leaders right now?

Nancy: Bush (George W.) is a Yellow. All the others are Violet except Jerry Brown who is a Violet / Tan. Perot is a Violet.

Other: What do you think of Perot?

Nancy: Well, I think he is spending a lot of money for nothing. He is not being drafted without payouts. He is spending a lot of money for nothing. I don't think he has a chance. Surely the American people are more intelligent than that! Of course, I said that about Bush. There is still another dark horse coming up. I have no idea who it is. Something that hasn't hit the board yet. Don't get all excited yet. There's time. This year will be a year full of surprises and scandals you never even dreamed of. I said that in January. You have to understand that's how the Bush administration works is by exposure. He doesn't do it with honesty; he does it by exposure. So if anything can be exposed on the poor Democrats between now and September, bank on it, it's going to be done. If a few Republicans have to sacrifice for it, that's okay. Believe it; anything that can be thrown out, will. He still has a couple more to go. He has proven to be a sturdy little dog. I kind of like his tenacity. I will love the day when he stands there and says, "yes, I did it, and so what? What's that got to do with the prices of potatoes in Idaho?" He's a smart man. We may not like him, but he's a smart man. I gain more respect for him every day.

Other: return to question about Indigos handling responsibility politically

Nancy: They will hand it back to the people. They don't need to be leaders. They have no need to be leaders or to win the game. They only need to play it.

Other: That's neat.

Nancy: I don't know that it's neat. There will be certain dangers attached to that which can be enormous. We haven't even dreamed of that yet. If we get just one in there who wants to see how he can manipulate the world – not win or lose, just manipulate. There goes the chain reaction.

Other: Would he do that for power?

Nancy: No, I don't think he would do it for power. He would do it just to see what the people would do. Have you ever watched these Indigos test animals? And tempt them? They'll tie tin cans on their tails, or they will do awful things just to see what the animal will do. They do it with machinery. They do it with

computers. They keep twisting their computers just to see how they can change the game. That's their name: change the game.

Other: Are they lacking expression and sensitivity?

Nancy: No! They have full capacity. They have more sensitivity than we do. But they're born for change. They are born with the instinctual need to make change. So not matter what they get, they are trying to figure out how they can make change with it. How can I reinvent something, do something with it, change it around? (Nancy relates an incident about a young Indigo.) They are always looking for ways to take one thing and create branches to it.

Other: Sometimes they break things.

Nancy: Sure. But that's a very good example of evolution. Every now and then when evolution takes a funny little twist, something breaks. Now do we fix it or do we go on? Go on and let those coming behind you fix it. The Violets were the beginning of the change. But everybody told them they were outcast if they followed it. And then have an insatiable need for TLC so they held back in order to have love. The Indigos love themselves. They're moving forward. The Violets and the Indigos are very similar in their unrestricted genius. If we get so disenchanted with what's out "here," we might listen to them.

Other: I don't see how their behavior is leading to this peaceful world.

Nancy: It's teaching us not to react to outside processes, that as long as we react to that instead of knowing ourselves, then we get caught. As long as we are reacting rather than acting... See, reaction takes away choice. Reaction deprives us of choice. When we react to someone, we are not acting. They are. THEY made the choice. We are simply following it. When we are within ourselves, we can still make a choice to act, react, move on or be. If we react, we lose our choice. But we can act according to our belief structure whether it fits theirs or not. That's what we see the Indigos doing. Now our choice is to learn to say, "You can do that if you want to, but this is as far as I'm traveling with you." And we have to, and this is where parents get in trouble. Parents provide a home, which means that everybody has to work within that home under a cohesive law. The Indigo is constantly supposed to change that law, and we are maybe of the old school and not willing to accept the change. So they may see a little Violet sitting here that they can initiate charges on. That creates major explosions throughout the whole thing, and then we forget who we were. But the Indigo does not forget who he is. That's the whole key. The more the chaos comes, the more we forget what was. We see that in our social structure today. The more chaotic it is out here, the less we can remember how it used to be. Why? Because we are too busy dodging the bullets in the chaos. And then it doesn't take long for new laws to be instilled. That's what chaos is all about. That's why chaos is good. That's the plus side of chaos – that it creates changes that you can't remember. After it's over, you say, "I don't remember how it was." But it is no longer, and you don't know how it got changed. Chaos changed it.

Other: What's going to happen to a crystal mother with Indigo children?

Nancy: Nothing. She will do much better than anyone else because she is reflecting time and time is changing. The Indigos are here to bring that change about. She'll have more tools to work with in making that change. Since those children are in her care, they obviously are part of her care unit and she obviously agreed to assist in this change. So she is ready for the next step. She just decided to help these people before she got there.

Other: Will she start acting like the children?

Nancy: She may. Which is not bad. That's what her job is. On the things that will take them to the plus side, she'll do them exactly the way they do. The things that will take them to the minus side, she'll do in reverse. This is true of all Crystals, no matter who they are with. If she is with a Blue, and the Blue is supposed to be going this way but is going this way, the Crystal will do everything here which looks wrong to the Blue. So if she's with the Indigo, and the Indigo is supposed to end up here and the Indigo is down here because some of his buddies are, she will do this which will block him and pull him back up here. But if he's here, then they're just trotting along. Side by side. That's when they are hugging and kissing and having good times together. Everything's ok. Crystal is one of the very best mothers (or a grandmother) for the Indigo to have at this time. Almost all Indigos are with Blues, Violets, and Crystals. A few of us others get to be grandmothers or grandfathers. In actuality, the Yellow is (and this is probably egotistic) is probably more in alignment with the Indigo than some of the other colors. Why do I say that?

Other: (Joking responses)

Nancy: The Yellow always gives choice. They may not take the choice along with you, but they'll give it to you. After you have taken choice, you may find yourself walking alone. But the Yellow will give you choice. And they don't give you a warning announcement. They say, "do what you want to as if you had all the rights in the world to do it, and once you do it, then we will make OUR choice." And that choice may be not to be with you anymore. And that's ok. The Indigos do that too. That is the trait that the Yellow has that is very, very much in alignment with the Indigo. Consistency, constant change, choice but not necessarily taking your choice. Our (Yellow's) affirmation is not necessarily a contract to do it. That's the major thing most people forget about a Yellow when they say, "That sounds like a great idea to me." That doesn't mean WE'RE buying it. That's where the rest of you make a big mistake. We may tell you that it sounds like a phenomenal idea, but we are not going over the cliff with you.

Other: They love to see us free.

Nancy: Absolutely! All the freedom you want. Go for it. Just don't expect to get paid for it. But that's a wonderful thing.

Other: Class joking about specific people.

Nancy: What else do you want to discuss?

Other: generalized question about Crystals having a hard time right now

Nancy: That's what you want to remember. Many Crystals ARE having a hard time right now. Many are feeling depressed, outdated, all kinds of Celtic(?) processes. But you have to remember that the Crystal is reflecting time. Time is chaotic and changing. The rules that were yesterday no longer work. There is no structure. So Crystals are having problems, not with people, but with Time. They don't even have to get out of bed to feel the chaos because Time is with them. So then you add the people who are reacting to the chaos or to the Crystal, so now the Crystal really has a problem because now they are looking at the people who are reacting to Time that they are reflecting. So the person sees it with Time and they see it in the Crystal and so the Crystal gets a boomerang effect. So it's a real tough time for the Crystal. The job for the Crystal is to learn to take the focus off the people who are reacting to Time and go with Time. What does that mean? It means to be impersonal. Be self-involved for that is what Time demands of us. To be self-involved. Self-sufficient. To be self-sufficient, not self-centered. What is the difference between being self-centered and self-sufficient?

Other: Variety of comments from class

Nancy: This is self. This is environment. Self-sufficiency means that you come from within to without. Self-centered means that you come from out to in. Self-centered means that you bring everything into you. Self-sufficient means that you bring all of you OUT. That's the difference. The more you bring OUT, the more room there is for this to come in from out here. Do you understand what I mean here? One more round.... Since we talked about personal consciousness, family consciousness, cosmic consciousness, universal consciousness. Here we go. If self produces out here, and out here produces out here, and out here produces out here, that allows out here to come into here. But if we are constantly pulling IN rather than putting OUT, then this supply ends after a while. Then as a self-centered person moves, and this stops, then what follows is depression because nothing is coming in. But as long as it is going out and coming in, you've got a good supply process. Self-sufficient. You rejuvenate yourself. It is self-rejuvenating. But as long as it is self-rejuvenating, this supply comes for a given length of time and that is all. And until it starts up back up again, depression starts in again. The person gets full of themselves and knocked down and full of themselves and knocked down. For a given length of time. So the key is learning how to be self-sufficient, which means bringing yourself out, not holding yourself in. That's what you have to remember.

Other: general discussion about some classmates' past

Nancy: That's the key we are getting at. Time is demanding that ALL governed by a few doesn't work. And that we're going to get back to where No One governs and everyone guides. That means that the worker can give suggestions to the boss, and the boss can give suggestions to the worker, and the worker can say yes or no, and the boss can say yes or no. And that will work in business. But it does require a constant and consistent meeting of minds. Almost every day they have to have a meeting of the minds to keep the minds regulated. That's what we call one-mindedness. Where one is no better than the other one. One may be more experienced. That one they listen to – to experience, not position. That's what will work in the future. Experience, not position. In the last 30 years we have gotten so high on the fact that if someone graduated from college with a degree but knew absolutely nothing about what they were talking about, they got the bosses' job. And here they are, trying to boss people who have long since learned way more than they will ever forget. By experience. And so, we have a lot of power trips going on without experience. That is where we have the chaos that is going on. That is what has to change. And that is what Time is all about – reversing that change and making us get more into a position of those less experienced listening to experience, not position. Experience sometimes gets lost in time; therefore, sometimes someone with no experience can come up with a better idea than the person with experience because they don't have the experience to clutter them. Then we can exchange and work, and now we become a real good team. Good things happen. That's the way it should work. But unfortunately, the aggressive part still wants power. It's not willing to work peacefully. It wants to be in charge, and its position is important. We learned that recently with our confrontation with Japan. We really got clear how still in America we use brute force. How they went around bashing the Japanese cars with sledge hammers. That's brute force. And that's got to go.

Every state in the Union has transients in it. A long time ago it was just California and Florida, where people from everywhere else went. Now I don't think there's a state in the Union that doesn't have transients. California will suffer in the next 5 years. We are going to lose more business out of California than any state in the Union. The more we lose, the worse it will get. We are making companies pay too high a price to be here. And they are leaving California. They will go to Nevada, Kentucky, Tennessee, Arkansas, Indiana, Oregon, Washington State, simply because it's easier to supply there. Now when these corporations move, they take their people with them – the good ones. And they leave behind the

ones they don't particularly care about. That's how they clean house. There's nothing wrong with that. That's the way life goes. And in that process, where they move, the lower positions are filled by indigenous. The key positions come from outside. That is always true. That's corporate law. All corporations operate that way by and large. They can do that easily with Toyota because it is not an American company, although it is an American-operated company. We have to be aware of that and look at it. You always find that in movement. We are going to see it a lot here because the more companies move out, the more the companies that are left will have to carry the burden. If it gets too heavy for them, they move quickly. So California is in for some interesting times if Wilson doesn't do some fast turn-arounds quickly. We are already losing reliable companies. Every day we are losing up to 5-6 reliable companies. If something isn't done soon, our burden is going to be too heavy. I have thought about moving myself. I don't like the tax laws here.

Other: We have the highest rate of welfare and social security...

Nancy: We do. And a lot of it is transient.

Other: We have a lot of retired people moving out of the state.

Nancy: We do. Because they get better treatment somewhere else. Nevada has one of the best educational systems in the country. Where here in California we pay \$44 per child in school, Nevada pays \$68. Per day per school. So there is a lot of differences we have been deprived of just because of numbers.

Other: discussion about Iowa and a classmate's story of a company that moved to Iowa to manufacture products for Iran. The products are not sold in Iowa, but the company is run in Iowa.

Nancy: A lot of businesses are moving to states that have low taxes and low processes, and they serve that state only in taxes. Their business is outside the state. That is a lucrative business for Iowa. They are getting the benefit of the company without having to deal with the product. It is an end process, not a sharing process. I would like to see more companies go into the Midwest, where there is no viable input of money, and let the rest of the country filter some money in there. {They can manufacture in one state but sell in the other states}. Even though it is Iranian with foreign extraction, a lot of money is still feeding the state.

Other: Can they integrate that way?

Nancy: What you have to realize is that we have seen China, Asia, Europe, Britain, and a certain amount of Hispanics integrate. The area that has integrated the least is the Middle East, and that's where we have our problems. That's the wonderful thing about integration. If those nationalities can come into our country and become a viable part of the society, how well they integrate will determine how their country will interact with our country. That's the migratory law. If they don't do it, then we're in trouble.

This is Tuesday. Did all the swallows come back? I saw a few but I was wondering if the rest of them did.

Other: They didn't see them.

Nancy: That's an interesting change that has been for a hundred years. Every year on a specific day the swallows always return to San Juan Capistrano. This is the first year in 100 years that only a few came back. It will be interesting to note if the rest come or if they don't come at all. It would also be an important thing to know where they did go (if they go somewhere else.)

Other: class laughter and discussion

Nancy: That's what we are talking about. EVERYTHING is different. Get used to it.

Other: You said a moment ago that how we integrate people from other countries...

Nancy: Yes, how well they integrate determines how well we get along with that country.

Other: People like Cubans, Iranians....

Nancy: Isn't that why we ALL came here? Everybody who came to this country came here because of conflict in their own country. As they became cohesive, their country became cohesive. History proves that throughout time that the freer they can work together here, the better their country operates. With Cuba, we see Cuba breaking down day by day. Another prediction: within the next 4 years Cuba will totally break down and will return to its old regime and Castro will commit suicide. He will not be assassinated.

Other: Is Imelda Marcos going to ...

Nancy: If the Filipinos follow all other rules, she probably will because they usually elect criminals, but let's hope they are a little more intelligent than that. But probably not. It's a prime hothouse. They did not acquire what they thought they would. It's human nature that when people don't get what they thought they would, they go back to the old rule, only to discover that the old rule can't work anymore. So they are in for a few more years of trials and tribulation.

Other: Class discussion about the Philippines. Is she a Violet?

Nancy: Yes, she is a Violet. What you don't understand is that she is not running. She is a figure-head behind a coup. Or in front of a coup. When she gets elected, she will not run the government. She'll just collect shoes. She is telling you that already. There is an army behind her that will run the country. Their consciousness is comfortable with that matriarchal process.

Other: I don't understand why it is so important to bury Marcos...

Nancy: For her it is a get-even process that says, "you may have killed him, but you have not deprived him." That's very Asiatic, by the way. Their religious structure says that their bodies cannot rest on foreign soil. The body must be in the indigenous place because that's where their God comes.

Other: The Philippines is blue, right? A Violet running a Blue country. They've got problems.

Nancy: That's right. This is a problematic time. What we don't realize is that people really don't want to take time to run a government. I think by and large, most people would really be happy to go back to sovereignty. Kings and queens, and we'll go do our things, and they can do their things. They can fight, and we'll just go do our little thing. We can't do that anymore. We are beyond the point of sovereignty. We are beyond that and it won't work anymore. We should watch England more. Their children are modern children who need to do modern things. We have Andy and Fergie, who need a divorce and are going to get it. Now the people are trying to decide if they should cut out their allowance. And they can't. But they are changing a lot. They have given up the Parliament. Now the Queen of England may be the last sovereign ruler that country ever has, which may be why she won't give it up. I don't know that Prince Charles would love to do it, but he will not do it as a King. That's what we are going to see. When she does give up the crown, it will go in storage. It may happen, as it has happened in other

countries like Russia, where the ones coming up became PART of the government rather than the government. In Lichtenstein, the King and Queen died a couple of years ago. The son has taken over, but he is not called the King; he is still called the Royal Prince. We see that in Monaco. He was not elevated to King; he is still called Prince. But he does not run the government. They are an honorary family.

Other: discussion about the Plantagenets

Nancy: Change is inevitable. We can't have a "we/they" system in a peaceful system. A peaceful system does not operate under a "we/they" law. It operates under and "we and us" law. And that's where we are headed. I see that as a very positive movement in human development. Getting adjusted to it is what we are having trouble with it. The Indigos do not have trouble getting used to this. And the Indigos under 10 will have no trouble getting used to this at all. By then the bodies will be totally different.

Other: Question about Indigos

Nancy: Well, no doubt about it, they will be the rebels. They will work our system until we get sick of it. Indigos who are between 17 and 24 now will turn the system every which way but loose. And we will learn that it is not a workable system. They are the ones who will really be sacrificed. The ones between 10 and 17 will come along and filter in new rules. And then the young ones will come along and put more pure rules in it, and then the ones after that will have everything set up. I see this as exciting, a time when we can intellectually observe human evolution in its change. If we can record it and get it written down and have it for the future to see, they can study and see how the change took place. We didn't get that opportunity when we changed from 2nd dimension to the 3rd dimension because even the Neanderthal to Cro Magnon was already in the 3rd dimension. It was the ones before Neanderthal who made the switch, and that's how we lost them. I see this as an incredibly wonderful time for man, if in all his awareness, if he learns how to record it and see it in its proper way. It does take us to perfection.
